General Emilio Aguinaldo, who fought for the independence of the Philippines and was captured by General Funston, still holds a strong place in the affections of the Pillpine people. This was demonstrated when he left the hospital the other day to pay a visit to his farm at Kawit 50 miles from Manila.

Aguinaldo has been in the hospital recovering from an operation for appendicitus but was permitted to go to his home to celebrate his 51st birthday.

Accompanied by his physician and a nurse, he made the 50-mile trip by automobile. Although his visit was not announced in advance, the news of his coming spread and the people of the vilages along the way gathered at the roadside and the children threw flowers into his automobile At one village the children waved American and Filipino flags and sang "Aguinaldo's March." At his home he was met by nearly all the villagers headed by a band and speakers gave him welcome. After spending the night at the farm he returned to the hospital.

Aguinaldo seems assured against want.
