The leakage in the Mills Addition pipe system has become so serious, due to the chemical action in the soil there, that it is absolutely necessary to temporarily cut off a portion of the water supply to that section of the City. In order to overcome this condition we are installing a large pump as quickly as possible. When this pumping plant is completed the situation will be greatly improved. A permanent solution, however, can only be reached when a large portion of the pipe in Mills Addition has been replaced. We are doing our utmost to temporarily take care of our customers in Mills Addition by supplying them limited service free of charge, pending the final solution of this problem.
