AT THE THEATERS

Mack Sennett's latest five-part comedy sensation, "Down on the Farm," released by United Artists (the "Big Four") will be the big feature at the Liberty Theatre Saturday.

"Down on the Farm" represents Mack Sennett's genius as "comedy king" at its height. Through five reels he carries the beholder through alternating scenes of comedy, tragedy, hilarious satire, serious drama and thrilling episodes, never permitting the action to languish an instant but keeping it up at a speed typically in "Sennett tempo."

The story relates the adventures in romance and finance of "a rusting corn-fed beauty," namely, Louise Fazenda. The romance of her life is provided by the "hired help" whose fists are as big as his heart. Finance is brought to the plot by the village banker—a kind of a cross between Shylock and Don Juan or a mixture of Turk and "shark." The farm hand loves her for herself alone. The village house broker and homewrecker desires her for an inheritance, the existence of which he, for a while, alone knows. But Cupid gets up in the country with Chanticleer and starts on the job with the sun, so it happens, after five reels of excitement, hilarity, bursts of laughter and thrills of suspense that love's labor isn't lost and that though the goin' may be rough in the country for romance, the altar and the preacher awaits at the end of the lane to do their duty by the sturdy of heart.

Sennett comedy experts to be seen in this pretentious spectacle and masterpiece of humor are Louise Fazenda, Marie Prevost, Ben Turpin, James Finlayson, Billy Armstrong, John Henry, Jr., Bert Roach, Harry Gribbon and (not to be overlooked), Teddy, Mr. Sennett's Great Dane, and Pepper, the latter's inherited enemy and expert inspector of cream. The entire Sennett menagerie of feathered and four-footed

folk is also graphically involved in the plot of "Down on the Farm."

A demonstration of the latest methods employed by coroners in the investigation of mystery receives visual treatment in the late Vitagraph picture, "The Winchester Woman." This subject, presenting Alice Joyce in the stellar role, will be seen at the Mondale Theatre on Friday and Saturday.

The new form of inquest proceeding, as shown here, consists of merely an informal discussion between the coroner and a group of representative citizens. According to the laws of New York, in the Long Island district of which the story is laid, it is no longer necessary for the coroner to impanel a regular jury

and hold a formal inquest in the case of mysterious death.

He merely calls together as many representative citizens and persons having knowledge of the surroundings of the case, as he chooses, and discusses the matter, reaching his own opinion.

"The Winchester Woman" is a film of dramatic elements. Miss Joyce plays in it the role of a woman who first suffers a trial for the murder of her husband, is acquitted, and later is hounded by a blackmailer through unusual experiences in a distant town.
