GENERAL DECLINE IN PRICES REMOTE

Sporadic Reductions Laid to "Disturbing Factors"

BASIC CONDITIONS SAME

Washington, May 30.—Despite the recent reductions in prices, little relief from the general reign of high prices is seen by the federal reserve board in its analysis of May business conditions, made public tonight. The board expressed the view that there has been no change in the underlying conditions responsible for the high cost of living.

Asserting that while "store sales" and a tendency to lower prices bear witness to the presence of "disturbing factors" which suggest the advent of wide alteration in price levels, the board declares it cannot accept the situation as a whole for its face value.

The explanation is added that there has been only a slight increase in production and there is no greater disposition on the part of the general public to economize and invest than had ruled heretofore.

RESERVE BOARD SEES NO SIGNS OF PRICE DROP

Slashing of Retail Figures Held No Indication of General or Permanent Reduction

Washington, May 31.—Doubt that the retail price slashing of the last fortnight presages any general or permanent reduction of the high cost of living is expressed by the federal reserve board in a survey of business conditions.

The board does not expect the cost of living to take a permanent downward trend until production begins to overtake consumption demands.

Its analysis strengthens the impression that price cutting has been due to enforced liquidation of stocks by retailers with widespread refusal of the public to buy at excessive prices, an important factor of the phenomenon.
