RED BLUFF, June 24.—Rachel C. Talbert, aged 90 years, mother of D. W. Hall, died at the Ball ranch, a few miles south of Cottonwood, Sunday afternoon following an attack of valvular heart trouble. The aged woman was a pioneer resident of this section, residing here for the past 41 years. She was born in New York, but moved to California 61 years ago.

GRASS VALLEY, June 24.—The Grass Valley primary and intermediary schools have closed for the term and the high school will close today.

YUBA CITY, June 24.—Fifteen concrete workers of the Yuba City-Nicolaus branch of the county highway went on strike when the contractor refused a demand for increased wages.

CLARKSBURG, June 24.—The fire which started from a Japanese threshing machine in the Glide district Saturday morning destroyed approximately 1,000 acres of standing grain in the Glide and Lisbon districts, over 100 tons of baled hay, 40 sacks of barley and two barns. The loss is estimated at from \$100,000 to \$200,000, partially covered by insurance.

SANTA ROSA, June 24.—Miss Helen Josephine Geary, youngest daughter of former Congressman Geary, has just been married to William Hubbard of Los Angeles. It was an outdoor event that took place at twilight.
