The object of the machine is to throw upon a screen a reproduction of every part of the body at one operation, enabling the physician to see the workings of all bodily organs at once. The screen is 24x30 inches in area.

This addition to the X-ray equipment, the management claims, gives the local hospital the most complete and expensive Roentgen ray room in Oregon.
