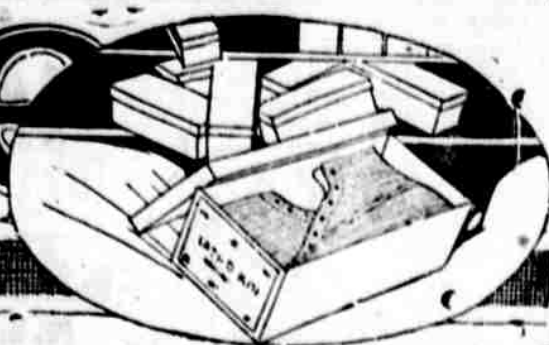

### COURT NOTES

The following judgments were made the last of the week by Supreme Judge D. V. Kuykendall: First State and Savings Bank vs. Herbert F. Moeck was dismissed, having been settled out of court. Horace G. Shidler against A. E. Gale and Klamath county, a dispute

over a road right of way was settled in favor of defendants.

T. H. Wilkerson and E. W. Wilkerson vs. Grover Minard was decided in favor of plaintiff who is to get \$600 with six per cent, from February 16, 1916, and costs.

Yank Lobert was given judgment against Albert Jackson in a collection suit.

Medford Grocery company vs. P. C. Knight and Ora M. Knight was dismissed.

Louie LeClair was granted a divorce from Eveleen Moore Leclair.

For upwards of half a century F. J. Glackmeyer has served continuously as sergeant-at-arms of the Ontario provincial legislature.
