and kept free of dunnage or other refuse for rats.

"Double ceiling should be avoided especially so in basements. Boxed in structures, such as uprights and roughly finished dwellings, plumbing, sinks and the like should be removed. Miscellaneous openings as light shafts, ventilators and windows should be screened preferably by twelve-guage wire screen with mesh not exceeding one-half inch. The grounds about the buildings are to be devoid of rat harborage and premises are to be kept clean and tree of rubbish."

In seaport cities, where the rare species of the brown rat and "Alexandrian" rat prevail, health officials are asked to make surveys to determine the presence or absence of ro dent plague.
