The extent to which bovine tuber culosis, if unconitolied, runs it
course through a herd of cattle tis thown in a recent report recelved by the Valted States Departiment of As rieultare from pae of its field in

calves and 2 bulls, calves and 2 bulls. Upon post-mor-
tem examination 6 of the animais showed such extensive lesions tha the entire carcuss was condemmed
and destroyed. All of the other re actors likewise showed lesions. though not as such an extensive nature ap to necessitate destruction of
