



## TUBERCULORIS AMONG CATTLE DECREASED

VANCOUVER, B. C., Aug. 17 .-Ten years ago 80 per cent of the cattle in British Columbia were infected with tuberculosis; last year only 3% or 3 per cent were infected and within a comparatively short time the number will be nil," W. W. Alton, of Cartier, provincial government veterinarian, states.

This year 4 per cent of the cattle inspected were ordered destroyed. but this is not an indication that tuberculosis is gaining ground again as the whole province has not been inspected yet and the disease is more prevalent in some districts than in others, Dr. Alton said.
