REAL KICK IN HAWAIIAN LIQUOR

HONOLULU, T. H., Aug. 29 (By Mail).—A bottle of "swipes," a liquor illicitly distilled in the Hawaiian Islands, which is said to have, by actual measurements, a "kick" of 250 pounds to the square inch, exploded recently and blew a hole in the arm of Antonio Lindo, messenger of the United States district court of Honolulu. The city physician repaired the damage with five stitches. Lindo was helping United States Marshal J. J. Smiddy clear his office of several consignments of "swipes," "okolehao" and other illegal drinks taken in recent raids, when the accident occurred.

"Swipes," it is said, is composed mainly of chewing tobacco, rafains and decayed fruit. Marshal Smiddy says a quart bottle of "swipes," two months old, produces a gas pressure of 250 pounds to the square inch.

BREEDERS' SALE AT FAIR SATURDAY, SEPT. 25; FAIR PROGRAM

Arrangements will be made for a sale of breeding stock the second day of the county fair, Saturday forenoon, September 25. The sale is open to all exhibitors of breeding stock. A number of choice bucks are already listed with the secretary and afford sheepmen opportunity to make some good purchases. Several breeds are represented. Some pure-bred hogs will also be entered.

Hay, and men to feed and care for the stock, will be provided for three days, September 23-24-25. The committee is anxious to have all agricultural exhibits in place by the evening of September 23. Livestock will be in better shape for exhibition if brought in Thursday, September 23, the day before the opening.

Following is the program:

Friday, September 23
10 a. m.—Livestock judging begins. The following order will be followed: Horses, Sheep, Hogs, Cattle.

1 p. m.—Boys' and Girls' Club livestock judging. The following order will be observed: Sheep, Hogs, Calves.

3 p. m.—Klamath County quarter mile derby. Free for all Klamath county horses. Purse \$150. First \$100. Second \$50. (2) Saddlehorse race. Stock saddles required. Purse \$100, split \$60 and \$40. (3) Free for all, three-eighths mile. Purse \$225, split \$150 and \$75. (4) Pony race. Purse \$15, first \$10, second \$5.

Saturday, September 25
10:30 a. m.—Sale of breeding stock.

1 p. m.—Review and parade of club members, club livestock, and other livestock exhibits on race track.

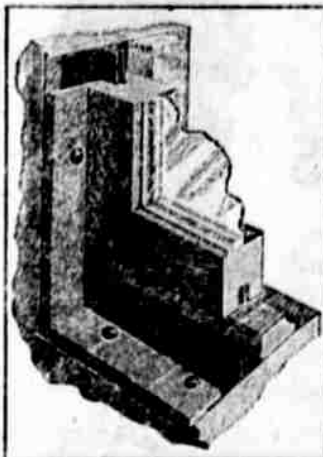
1:45 p. m.—Racing, same program as first except Klamath county derby will be three-eighths of a mile instead of quarter as on the first day.

3:30 p. m.—Foot races and other field sports.

NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS TO MAKE STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Pursuant to ordinance and order of the Common Council of the city of Klamath Falls, Oregon, notice is hereby given that proposals will be received by said Council for making the improvement designed for the Alley passing from Fifth to Sixth St. parallel with Main St. through the center of Block 37, original town. Said improvement to be made in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City Engineer and for one of the classes of improvement mentioned in said plans and specifications and the ordinance ordering said improvement, which said ordinance No. 528 was adopted on the 13th day of September, 1920, and approved by the Mayor on the 14th day of September, 1920.

Said plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer being on file in the office of the Police Judge and in the office of the said Engineer.

The proposed contract will be let in one contract, and the time in which the same is to be completed is fixed by said ordinance on or before October 15, 1920. Bids must be filed with the Police Judge for submission to the Council not later than 8 o'clock p. m. of the 4th day of October, 1920, and the bids will be considered by the Council immediately thereafter at the Council Chamber in said city.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check on some responsible banking institution in an amount equal to 5% of the aggregate amount of the proposal, the same to be forfeited to the city by the successful bidder upon failure to enter into contract and bond for the faithful completion of the said improvement in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor.

The City of Klamath Falls reserving the right at all times to reject any and all proposals. The award to the successful bidder is hereby made contingent upon the sale of the bonds that will be authorized for providing funds for making such improvement.

The plans, specifications and estimates above referred to embrace and provide that the proposed improvement may be made, using Standard Bitulithic pavement, oil macadam pavement or concrete pavement, and bids are invited for each class in addition to grading, curbing and drainage.
