

DAZZLING SIGN AT UNDERWOODS

The corner of Seventh and Main, occupied by Underwood's Pharmacy, presents quite a metropolitan appearance since the installation of some new electric signs by the Link River Electric Company.

The signs were made by special order, the Federal Electric company of New York doing the work.

One extends the full length of the store front and on one end bears the word "Drugs." The central portion of the sign reads "Underwood's," while the other end informs the passer-by that "Kodaks" may be found there also.

The letters are made of a white material called "Opalex" and are inset into a metallic background that is covered with black smalts and outlined in gold leaf. It makes a striking day sign, while at night the letters stand out in a brilliant glow, being illuminated by 25 powerful lamps.

The other sign is made in similar style, bearing the word "Drugs." It is in a vertical position and reaches from the top of the building to the upper part of the lower story. This sign may be easily read at a distance of ten blocks. It is so arranged that an electric motor flashes one letter at a time until the entire word is spelled out. The whole sign is then illuminated for a few seconds and the process repeated.
