## SUTTON GETS \$1,500 AWARD

The jury in the case of Ed. Sutton, well known rancher, against the Keno Power company, last night returned a verdict for \$1,500 in favor of the plaintiff. The trial of the suit began Monday. Sutton asked approximately \$2,500 for failure on the part of the defendant to carry out a contract to supply electric current for use on his ranch.

The jurors were Frank Ward, foreman; A. Hilliard, W. H. McPherron, E. P. Combs, C. H. Withrow, George Bloomingcamp, Fred Bamber, M. S. Centers, Arlie Worrell, A. C. Beals, H. F. Phillips and W. W. Finley.

C. F. Stone, W. A. Wiest and Augustine Donovan, attorneys for defendant, today filed a motion to set aside the verdict and grant a new trial on the ground that the evidence introduced was not sufficient to sustain the verdict reached by the jury.

This case was the last set down for trial on the present calendar, and the jury was excused last night until further call.
