The hay production and marketing committee of the Klamath county farm bureau has under way a survey of the alfalfa hay which is being offered for sale. It has, also, made extensive inquiries in various sections regarding market conditions. While in some sections there is a surplus of hay over last year, there are other sections where there is a greater demand for hay than last year. The committee has on hand now inquiries for more than 25 carloads. It is, also, in touch with some excellent dairy stock that can be secured reasonably.

There has been some speculation as to whether or not it would be possible to handle some of the large sunflowers with an ordinary cutter. Anyone having doubts with regard to this can soon be convinced that there is no trouble along this line by watching operations at Mr. Taylor's.

Langell valley district expects to meet the rabbit problem more than half way this year. They have called a meeting at Lorella for Saturday night for the purpose of making definite plans for carrying on a rabbit campaign for the coming winter.

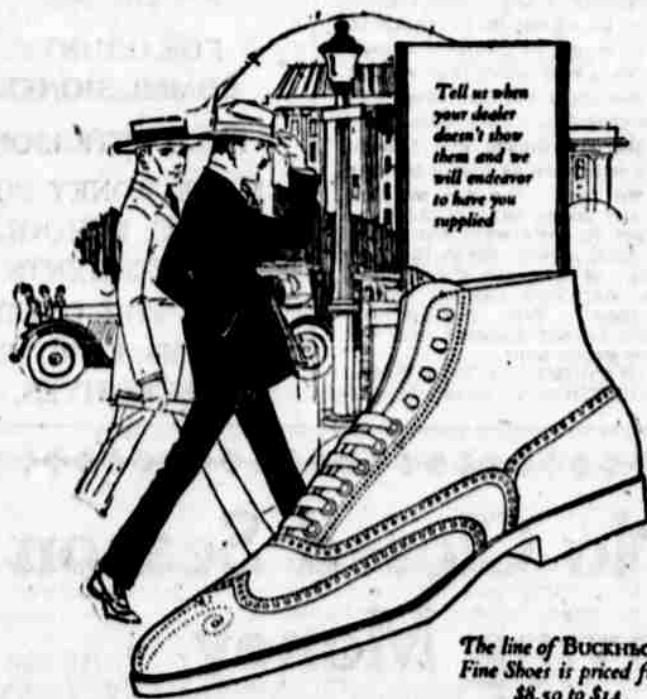
