two for he saw active service in the Philippines with Troop G, Sixth United States Cavalry, during the Moro insurrection. He was the youngest man in the troop. He was first made a sharpshooter, and for signal bravery in two engagements on an expedition was made permanent orderly to Colonel Day, in charge of the squadron at Malabang. After that he distinguished himself in a battel with the Aguinaldo forces. After his return home he was in the aviation service until he was in the aviation service until discharged.

Soon after the world war started Buck Jones secured a position breaking horses for the French government in Chicago, from which position he effected his transfer to France. He was first assigned to the aviation forces and made sevto the aviation forces and made several air trips over the German lines; but his knowledge of horsemanship could not be hidden, and he was given a post instructing French mounted officers at a remount station just behind the lines.
