A short method of making flake loaves, or rye loaves and twelve loaves. 1 1/2 cups cold water; 2 1/2 tablespoons sugar; 1 level teaspoon salt; 1/2 cup cold butter; 1/2 cup cold milk; 1/2 cup cold cream; 1/2 cup cold lard or oil. Cream milk, put in ground flour in top small container, mix well. Knead down and let rise 1 1/2 hours until double the bulk. Mold into loaves, let rise 1 1/2 hours, bake in moderate oven.
