PINK BALLOTS FOR MISSOURI WOMEN

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo., Oct. 19. Women in Missouri will not be required to cast their vote on special ballots in the November election. This is the substance of an opinion delivered to secretary of the state by Attorney General Frank W. McAllister.

The attorney general held that what is known as the "pink ballot law," passed by the last general assembly, is void and should be disregarded. The law requires that the ballots for women shall be printed on pink colored papers, hence the name of the law.

In his opinion the attorney general said that there was no necessity for the law; that the full franchise privliege has been granted for women by the 19th amendment to the federal constitution. The law apparently violates and scecrecy of the ballot box in distinguishing between the color of the ballots for men and women, he said.
