GAINS 2 IN 10 YEARS

DALLAS, Tex., Oct. 22.—Cochran county, Texas which gained two inhabitants in the last ten years, and now has a population of 67, accord-

ing to figures announced by the United States census bureau for 1920, dates its history back to the early settlement of West Texas, and has less than one inhabitant for every square mile.

The first census of the county was taken in 1900, when enumerators succeeded in finding 25 residents. During the next ten years the county had a phenomenal growth—from 25 to 65 inhabitants, or 160 per cent. But the "boom" petered out in the next ten years and but two more people were added to the total.

Cochran county was formed in 1874 from another large county which now lies to the east of it. It is situated on the Texas-New Mexico line and was named for Robert Cochran, a Boston man who settled what is now Cochran county and opened a frontier store before the Civil war. Edwards is the only settlement in the county and is reached by a small railroad from New Mexico. Big ranches occupy most of the county.

There is no county organization and not even a postoffice in the county.

SINGER DEVOTED TO AMERICA

Monday night Klamath Falls people will have an opportunity to hear Mile. Verlet, the "Little Belgian Queen of Song," as she is lovingly called in her own home country near Brussels, at a concert at the Elks Temple.

Mile. Verlet came to America direct from the Paris Grand Opera company where she was premier coloratura soprano. She had a brilliant reputation which she acquired in musical centers of Europe, and her coming to America has only increased her fame. For American music lovers were not at all disappointed in Mile. Verlet's marvelous voice, in spite of her great reputation.

Mile. Verlet was in Brussels, or rather at her home near Brussels, when the war broke out. Of course, his sister, mother safely out of the close their home and flee in haste, just getting away before the Germans advanced.

Her brother was less fortunate, however. He was a retired officer in the Belgian army and after seeing his sister mother safely out of the country, he determined to go back and offer his services to fight the foe. Before he could reach Antwerp, however, he was arrested by the Germans. "Arrested" we call it—but the German way of making the arrest in this case was to knock Mr. Verlet down, beat him with the butts of their rifles and then force him to march several miles to Brussels, where he was imprisoned and left two days without food. But the goaler was a Belgian, so Mr. Verlet was able to escape by bribing him, and was finally taken to a hospital. Mr. Verlet's injuries proved so serious that he spent 14 months in bed. He was quite unable to work and so escaped deportation to Germany.

Mile. Verlet herself has become an enthusiastic American. While she is intensely devoted to her own country still, the warm reception she has received in America has caused a great affection to grow up in her heart for the people of this country. So she is very happy singing her way into the hearts of her new friends.
