HERE'S THE STUFF THAT

WASHINGTON, Nov. 29.—During the two month's front porch campaign conducted at Marion, Ohio, visitors to the republican nominee acquired a fondness for the waffles made by Mrs. Warren G. Harding, who has since been elected to become the first lady of the land.

Here is the formula for the waffles, which, with creamed clipped beef, fresh fruit and good coffee, constitute the Harding Sunday morning breakfast the year around, whether in Marion or Washington. Two eggs, two tablespoons of sugar, two heaping tablespoons of butter, one pint of milk, one pint of flour, two heaping teaspoons of baking powder, one teaspoon of salt. Beat yolks of eggs, and sugar and salt and milk and flour; next add melted butter. Just before ready to bake add baking powder and beaten whites of eggs. Cook in hot waffle irons. Use plenty of butter and maple syrup.
