Major Clark, who came here in advance to make arrangements for the men, is one of the very few officers who fought through the war with the regiment and remained alive.



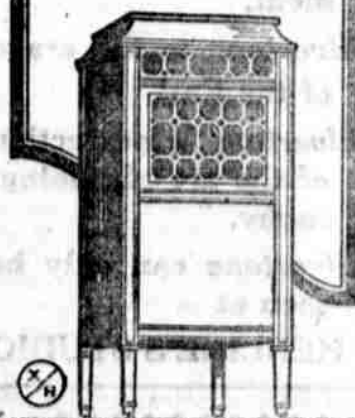
