"Moreover, if a considerable part of that ten billions were applied to the payment, of outstanding Liberty bonds, those bonds, which are now worth about 85 cents on the dollar, would advance in market value and perhaps reach par. People who loaned their money to the government on the assurance that the loan would be a safe investment, but who have witnessed a 15 per cent decline in the value of their security, will scarcely favor a cancelation of the \$10,000,-000,000 debt when it could be applied to the payment of the obligations the government owes them.

"Cancelation of the \$10,000,000, 000 debt would be a relief to the peo ple of European nations to that exne, but it would be in off ditional burden upon the American people to a similar extent. Cancela tion of the debt would postpone the time when the United States will be able to pay its own bonds, would exdend the period during which American taxpayers must raise money to pay interest, and would delay the time when Liberty bonds will be restored to par.
