Aerial Paths to National Forests

SACRAMENTO, Cal. Jan. 27.—Aerial paths to all national forests in California, Oregon, Washington, Montana, Idaho, Nevada and Utah will radiate from Mather Field here during the coming fire season, under plans being made at present. Five aerial patrols will be on duty constantly during the fire season, with reserve aviators on call at Mather Field. It is a theory of the army that forest patrol work is excellent training for aviators and close cooperation between the war department and the department of agriculture, which controls the forests, has been decided upon. In all, five air squadrons and 1,000 men will form the complement of Mather Field under plans announced unofficially. The field it is believed, soon will be the largest air service training station in the western department of the army. A forest rangers' school, intended to bring better co-operation with the army aviators, is being conducted at the field. To the same end, a meet-

ing of forest superiors of California, with representatives from several western states and from Washington D. C. will be held January 30. Improvements to care for the added personnel at the air field are expected to consist of twenty four sets of permanent quarters for married officers.
