## APPLE GROWERS WILL SHIP WITH CITRUS RAISERS

LOS ANGELES, April 29.—A fleet of fast fruit carrying vessels to ply on regular schedule between Pacific and Atlantic points, became a possibility today with the announcement that apple growers of the northwest and the citrus industry of California will combine their tonnage for future negotiations with steamship companies.

Co-operation between the two industries was effected by C. S. Whitcomb, vice president of the California Fruit Growers exchange, who has just concluded a trip of two weeks through the northwest. Plans for a water schedule through the canal on products of Pacific Coast industries that have been brought to the verge of ruin by excessive rail freight rates, were developed by Whitcomb during conferences with growers' organizations at Yakima, Wenatchee, Seattle and Portland.

As the initial step toward effecting the plan, the Yakima valley growers, through the Yakima commercial club, have pledged 2000 carloads of apples to be combined with the citrus fruit shipments from California. It was announced by the California Fruit Growers exchange, upon the return of Whitcomb. The apple and citrus seasons dovetail perfectly and under the combined industries plan, a stream of regular fruit cargoes will be afforded the steamship lines throughout the year.

## Bridegrooms' Vanity Displayed By Show Of Big Bank Rolls

SAN FRANCISCO, April 29.—Officials of the San Francisco marriage license bureau say that because prospective bridegrooms endeavor to display money in large rolls, their office is called upon to change more money than any other county office except that of the treasurer. A small boy is kept busy by the bureau getting \$10, \$20 and \$50 bills changed.

"This is the greatest place in the world for a man to put up a 'front,'" Grant Munson, deputy county clerk, in charge of the bureau, said recently. "Men, young, middle-aged and old, come here with their prospective brides and take out marriage licenses. They know the license is \$2, but they come with about all the money they can lay their hands on, done up in a roll.

"They change the money before they come into the biggest bills they can get and then come out here and make a flash before their bride's-to-be.

"Of course some men do not do this. The really successful business man usually pays in silver. It is not unusual for a wealthy man, particularly if it is his second or third marriage, to show no bills at all but to ask the bride if she has any change.

"Men who have been married before generally show the wisdom of never showing too much money."
