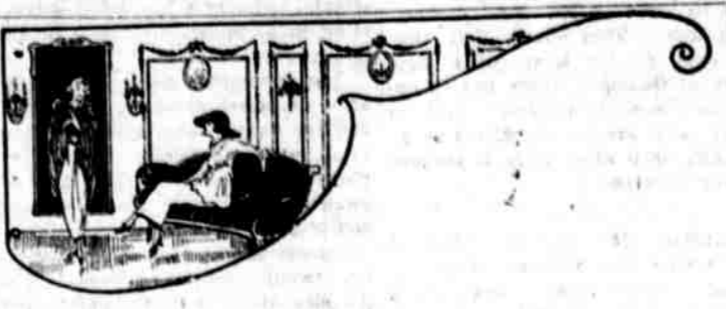
PROCLAMATION
