Wood Scarce This Winter, According to Present Outlook

Have you thought about your winter wood supply?

Indications point to a small reserve of both blocks and slabs in Klamath Falls when winter starts four months from now.

Last year when money was easily obtainable local wood dealers piled up a wood surplus in the summer. O. Peyton, one of the dealers, states he had 1000 cords of blocks on hands last winter, but this winter expects to have not more than 250 cords.

"There's a cash demand for wood in California now," he said. "We can dispose of all we have and collect immediately. The dealer cannot afford to borrow the money, if he could get it, to create a wood reserve here. Two or three thousand dollars can be quickly tied up in a wood pile and it remains there all summer."

Three cars of blocks from local box factories is said to be the average daily shipment from here to California, and it looks like good advice to the householder to suggest the getting in of the winter wood supply "while the getting is good."
