OREGON BREVITIES

MEDFORD, Oct. 26.—While driving through the country about seven miles from Rogue River, Mrs. Gunning Davis stopped her car and descended the bank of a small creek to get water for the radiator, when she discovered a small snake with two heads, and persuaded Darrell Garmon, a youth who was fishing near by, to pick it up for her. Preparing to Drill More Water Wells Fort Rock Valley

BEND, Oct. 26.—To take over drilling operations in the Fort Rock valley where an apparently inexhaustible supply of artesian water was tapped by John M. Perry on the Ernst ranch, E. R. Walker has arrived in Bend from Pasco, and expects that his rig will be here shortly. Because of the time necessary for transportation, it is expected that drilling can hardly be started short of two weeks.
