AMERICAN EYES FIFTY PER CENT DEFECTIVE

WASHINGTON, Nov. 18.—That more than fifty per cent of the men and women employed in American industry are sufferers from defective vision is one of the important findings of the Hoover committee for Elimination of Waste in Industry.
The report, as prepared by Herbert Hoover, Secretary of Commerce, and seventeen nationally known engineers who worked with him, is being issued by the Federated American Engineering Societies, under whose auspices the gigantic survey was undertaken.
"It is estimated that 25,000,000 workers have defective vision requiring correction," Mr. Wallace states. He uses the Waste report giving a total of 42,000,000 men and women in industry as his basis for fixing the percentage of suffering from poor eyesight.
It is the experience of numbers of plant managers that the correction of sub-standard vision brings increased quantity and quality of production, sufficient to pay for the cost of the same. That is now being done by a number of plants.

FAMOUS RESORT IN EAST WILL USE OREGON LUMBER
NEW YORK, Nov. 18.—Coney Island's new boardwalk will be surfaced with Douglas fir. The lumber contract for that portion of the walk has just been awarded a San Francisco concern on specifications calling for 1,600,000 feet 2x4 vertical grain Douglas fir of the decking grade.
When completed, the Coney Island improvement is expected to rival the boardwalk that made Atlantic City famous, which walk also contains a great deal of Douglas fir as well as West Coast spruce and Port Orford cedar.

PORTLAND, Nov. 18.—The Oregon Dairymen's co-operative league members are to vote on a referendum, December 8th on the question of disbanding the organization suggested by the board of directors. The disbanding might be followed by organizations in different zones.

COLORADO MINERS STRIKE AGAINST WAGE REDUCTION

DENVER, Nov. 18.—Colorado Fuel and Iron company reported today that many miners are working in the Los Animas and Huertano counties where the strike was called yesterday as a protest against thirty per cent wage reductions.
Union leaders reported that there was a general response to the strike orders.

PILIPINOS TABOO LOVE MAKING IN SCHOOLS

MANILA, P. I., Nov. 6.—(By Mail)—Love making in the schools of Leyte, capital of the province of Taeloban, has been made unlawful by the municipal council. The purpose of the ordinance, according to officials is to stop courting in the schools not only between the pupils but between the teachers and pupils, who, it is asserted have neglected their duties.
The penalty for violation of the ordinance is a fine of from \$2.50 to \$100 and in case the fine is unpaid, the defendant must suffer imprisonment until the fine is worked out at the rate of fifty cents a day.
