

TWO AMERICANS ADOPT 17,000 WAR ORPHANS

ALEXANDROPOI, Dec. 6.—Two Americans have become fathers by adoption of 17,000 homeless Armenian orphans in this far-off city. Milton D. Brown, of Malden, Mass., and William Martin, of New York, have adopted the waifs on behalf of the American Near East Relief Committee. The young men, who have been carrying on relief work in Armenia many months, plan to take some of the children to America and to have them educated in American schools.

MAIL ROBBERY NOT LUCRATIVE PRACTICE

Robbing the government trains is a dangerous and unremunerative occupation, according to Joe J. Johnston, post office inspector here in charge of the Kansas City district. Mr. Johnston admits that registered mail robbers have been in distinct vogue recently, but he insists that they do not really offer the opportunity to get rich quick that those who attempt them believe exists.

Rather, says Mr. Johnston, they offer a remarkable opportunity to get killed or sent to prison quick. "They all get killed or sent to prison in the long run," he remarks, "and usually it isn't such a very long run, either."

Robbing the mails, the veteran post office inspector says, probably will be less attractive than ever since the government has stationed marine guards on trains carrying valuable mails, and provided a corps of "devil dogs" for mail trucks and guards for rooms where mail is handled.

"Under Secretary Denby's orders to marines," says Mr. Johnston, "about the only reason that is considered valid for the escape of the bandit, is that the bandit has killed the marine first."

'49 FINANCIER KEEPS OPEN BANK WITHOUT CUSTOMERS

Promptly at nine o'clock each morning, John Nichols, a retired banker of Dutch Flat, California, opens his place of business, spends a few minutes behind the counter as though to wait on customers, sits for a time on the front porch and then goes home. Everything in the bank, including the scales, which have weighed millions of dollars worth of gold dust, is kept intact, but there is no money left the safe and no business transacted.

Nichols kept his bank open for more than twenty years after the hydraulic mines closed, but finally liquidated five years ago. He came here as a youth in 1862 and for thirty years handled an average of \$750,000 annually in gold dust, the depositors often refusing even to accept a receipt.

RUSSIAN RENTS INCREASED 2,000 TIMES OVER OCTOBER

Tenants who wax angry when landlords add 15 or 20 per cent to their apartment rents have less cause for complaint than tenants in Petrograd. By official decree, according to a radio dispatch from Moscow, Petrograd rents have been increased by 2,000 times the amounts paid on October 1.

Previous to last summer, no rents at all were paid under the bolshevik regime. In accordance with the new economic policy, nominal rents were instituted several months ago, persons paying perhaps 2,000 rubles monthly for a large apartment.

This sum, in American money, represented about 2 cents monthly, but was, perhaps, one-fifth of the tenant's monthly income.
