CHINESE RAP SECRECY

Students Stage Parade of Protest in San Francisco

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 16.—A parade in protest against "direct negotiation" of the Shantung question by China and Japan and also against what they term the "secret diplomacy" of the conference at Washington to discuss the limitation of armaments and Far Eastern questions, was held here by many hundreds of Chinese students who are sympathetic with the South China or Canton government. The students ranged in age from 3 to 30 years and many were dressed in native costume.
