**VANITY BOTTLES
2,000 YEARS OLD
REACH LONDON**

LONDON, Jan. 3.—A consignment of eastern vanity bottles 2,000 years old has just reached London. Some were found with mummies of Egyptian women of fashion; others came from a Roman tomb in Nazareth.

They are stibium pots from the toilet tables of vanished beauty. Stibium is a preparation of finely powdered antimony with which the Egyptian women darkened their eyelids and pencilled their eyebrows.

Time has made these little vanity bottles very thin and iridescent. They shine with beautiful prismatic tints of rich gold, green, blue, purple and red. When they arrived, they were full of desert sand. Held against the light, they show that a dark deposit has eaten its way into the glass: it is 20 centuries old eye paint.
