NATIONAL GUARD SHOWS NET PROFIT DURING PAST YEAR

SALEM, Jan. 9.—Oregon derived a net profit of \$119,077 in the operation of its National Guard during the past year, according to an annual financial statement issued by George A. White, Adjutant General of the State.

This year's profit was nearly four times as much as was derived from the Government's payrolls last year, due to the increase in size of the State service and success in meeting all Government requirements for pay of the Oregon citizen soldiers.
