BREAKS SWIM RECORD

Johnny Weissmuller Clips Nine Seconds Off 500 Meter Time

SACRAMENTO, July 13.—Johnny Weissmuller, 'the human fish,' who has shattered almost every record hung up in water racing, last night clipped off nine seconds from the world's record in the 500-meter event at the Riverside baths. His time for that distance was 6 minutes 42.3 seconds. The record for the swim was 6 minutes 51.3 seconds, made by Herbert E. Vollmer of New York, in that city in 1916.

Weissmuller's time here will stand as an official world record, as the event was held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the National Amateur Athletic Union of the United States.
