UNIVERSITY WILL HONOR PIONEER JESUIT PRIEST

SANTA CLARA, Cal., Aug. 17.—University of Santa Clara authorities have announced that on August 27 the cornerstone will be laid here for a memorial arch to be dedicated to Father Aloysius V. Raggio, a pioneer Jesuit priest of the university.

"St. Claire's Gate", as the arch is to be called, will bear the following inscription: "A tribute of love, a token of gratitude from the people of Santa Clara to Rev. Aloysius V. Raggio, S. J., on the sixtieth anniversary of his entrance into the Society of Jesus, September 1, 1922."

TAILOR'S HAPPINESS WAS TURNED TO DEEP DESPAIR

LOS ANGELES, Cal., Aug. 17.—Aaron Krusof, tailor, purchased with his savings a thriving little tailor shop on West Second street, close in. When his profits for the first two weeks averaged \$100 a week he agreed with the former owner's claim that he had bought a bonanza. He was happy.

Presently a tunnel contractor appeared with his crew. They tore away the sidewalk in front of the shop. They dug and shoveled and scraped the street away before his astonished eyes. Soon he and his

little shop were left perched on the edge of a cliff, far above the traffic level of the tunnel, hopelessly beyond reach of the gentlemen who bought to have trousers pressed. It is the city's fault, Krusof believes. He has asked the city council for \$50 a week damages for the time he has been marooned from his customers.
