AIRPLANES TO BE BROUGHT TO FAIR IN JACKSON CO.

MEDFORD, Aug. 31.—Through the courtesy of Lowell H. Smith, in charge of the airplanes that are patrolling the Oregon and Washington forests, arrangements have been made to have the government airplanes here during the Jackson county fair, September 13 to 16. This will be welcome news as it adds another big feature to the already splendid program arranged for the entertainment of the thousands of people who will be present from all over Oregon and California.

Capt. Smith does not say how many planes he can send here but has promised the maximum number consistent with patrol duties. Part of the credit for securing these planes is due to Senator Chas. J. McNary who secured permission from the chief of the air service in Washington, D. C., on request of a representative of the fair board.

ORIGIN OF MINE FIRE MAY NEVER BE SOLVED

JACKSON, Calif., Aug. 31.—Scores of rumors as to how the fire may have started are heard in Jackson. That the flames were caused either by a short circuit in the electric lighting system or a cigarette butt carelessly thrown seem to be the two most generally accepted theories.

It was stated that Sunday afternoon two of the crew had been engaged in doing repair work among the timbering at the point where the flames were first discovered at midnight, Sunday night, by Clarence Bradshaw, Steve Pasalich and Michael Jago, the only three men to escape from the burning mine. Charles Johnson and Thomas Cowling were the workmen in question and they finished their repair job at 2:30 in the afternoon and came to the surface at 4 o'clock when the shifts changed. Neither of these men smoked, it is said.

It is hardly probable that the origin of the fire will ever be determined. There is a rigid order prohibiting smoking in the underground depths and violations among the men call for dismissal.
