ITALIANS TO ENGAGE IN BLACK SEA SHIPPING
CONSTANTINOPLE, Sept. 7.—The Lloyd Triestino Shipping company, an Italian concern, has concluded an agreement with the Russian Soviet government which gives it a virtual monopoly of the carrying trade of the Russian Black sea ports. The company is to be the only foreign shipping concern allowed to engage in the Russian coastwise trade. This hitherto has been restricted to Russian flag vessels.
