MISSOULA, Mont., Sept. 8.—The Bitter Root valley, north of here, is to have a new male train to be known as the "Bachelor's Special."

The new train is believed here to be the only exclusive "male train" operated on any railroad in the United States at the present time.

The decision to limit the train to men only was reached because the train will handle a large amount of freight, necessitating considerable switching. On account of the hazard incident to the switching, railroad company officials thought it advisable to limit the passenger service to men.

Mining Revival Is Seen In Central Idaho

BOISE, Idaho, Sept. 8.—The mining belt of east central Idaho, comprising the counties of Butte, Lemhi, Custer and Blaine, where virtually all mining has been dormant for the last two years, is again forging to the front according to Stewart Campbell, state mine inspector.

"This revival is adding considerably to the general improvement in mining throughout the state," says Campbell, "and will be a material factor in increasing Idaho's mineral importance, as well as adding to the general improvement in mining which the state is witnessing."
