considered a waste product in sugar milling.

Originally, the alcohol produced by Foster was used only in the company trucks and automobiles but later, enough was manufactured to supply employees of the plantation, who live in Haimukapoko. A simple apparatus composed of a few thin pipes and an open burner is required to burn the alcohol to supply heat for cooking, and these have been placed in all of the homes here.

Foster said that Maui can produce only enough alcohol in this fashion to supply the needs of the island's population and that no surplus would be available for use on the other islands of Hawaii.
