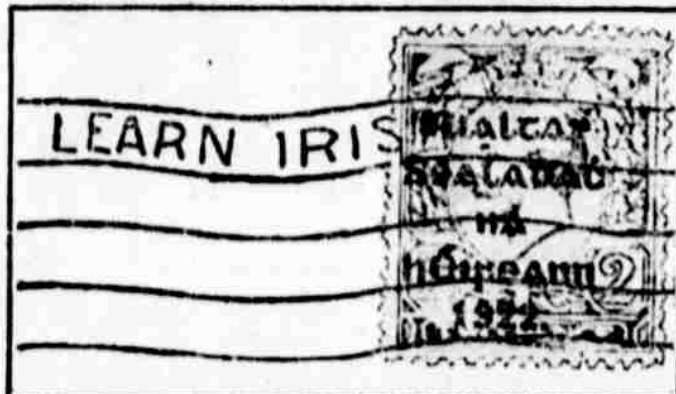

SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINE IS FAVORED BY C. OF C. BOARD

protect the fruit crops and to insure the continuous and normal operation of our mills during the limited season favorable to our lumber industry. This, we contend, is essential to the general welfare of all the citizens in our community.

Referring to the Natron cut-off, we have a telegraphic statement from the president of the Union Pacific railroad to the effect that the Union Pacific would complete the Natron cut-off in case they gained a controlling interest in the Central Pacific.

Klamath county has two possibilities to secure an outlet to the east. One by way of Modoc Northern, which survey we understand is complete, and the other is the proposed connection between Crane and Odell connecting with the Klamath-Natron line.

We cannot look forward with much hope for immediate development under an independent Central Pacific, as we do not know who will control the company, nor how well it will be financed to develop our country.

So far as we know, the only other line interested in the Central Pacific, besides the Union Pacific and Southern Pacific, is the Hill Lines, and no promise of development has come from this source.

In summarizing our recommendations, we have to report that our committee is unanimous in the statements that we make, and we believe that if the interests of the county can unite behind the program that we have outlined, it will be a forward step to the general prosperity of not only our own county, but Southern Oregon as well.

As mentioned above, we can expect relief from heavy freight rates when the Natron cut-off is completed, and from the information given out by the railroad officials, we are of the opinion that the construction will be completed earlier under the Southern Pacific control than either under the Union Pacific or the independent Central Pacific.

only look forward to the completion of the Natron cut-off from the Union Pacific in case the entire lines are given to them, according to their own statement.

We have stated that it is the opinion of the railroad officials and the heavy shippers of our county that better service can be maintained under a unified road to San Francisco, and this we believe is more probable under Southern Pacific control since we do not believe the Union Pacific will gain control of the lines in this territory.

Since we believe that the Modoc Northern is a more feasible road for this territory than the line across Oregon to Crane, and since we believe that the Union Pacific will not gain control of the lines in this territory, we believe that our outlet to the East will be realized at an earlier period under Southern Pacific control than under either Union Pacific or the Central Pacific.

We have had this matter under consideration for several weeks analyzing statements made to us and have reviewed statements made to other territories as to what we might expect out of the present situation, and we are unanimously of the opinion that it will be to the best interests of the State of Oregon for the Southern Pacific lines north of San Francisco, and we recommend that the Klamath county chamber of commerce, along with other civic and trade organizations of the county, so inform the Interstate Commerce commission and the Southern Pacific company of our situation.

The committee recommends that the board submit the report of the committee to the membership in good standing for their approval, and if approved have it announced as the program of the chamber in the present controversy.

NEAR EAST AID CALL ANSWERED

County Chairman Says Liberal Offerings Made at Local Churches

"Klamath Falls is already busy answering President Harding's call for aid for Near East sufferers," stated Arthur R. Wilson, county chairman of the Near East relief this morning. "In addition to liberal offerings at the churches on Sunday, the Kedron club, Mrs. Eva Clemens president, has pledged more than sufficient funds to care for three children at a cost of \$60 each per year."

Before President Harding issued his call for aid he was assured of hearty cooperation by the Red Cross, the Y. M. C. A., Knights of Columbus, Federal Council of Churches, Jewish Joint Federation committee and other organizations.

Dispatches received the last day or so confirm earlier reports of new born infants dying in their mother's arms, of lost children hunting frantically for their murdered parents, of deaths by starvation and suicide.

At noon today the Rev. J. J. Hansaker addressed the employees of the Klamath Lumber and Box company at 4 P. M.
