Whether the Klamath country will be best served and more prosperous by throwing open the country to competitive railroads as is made possible by the decision of the U. S. Supreme C ourt of May 29, 1922, ordering the Southern Pacific Company to surrender its exclusive control of the Central Pacific, or shall Klamath Falls remain indefinitely under the sole control of the Southern Pacific, as at present.
