Boy Shot by Hunting Companion Saturday Fails to Recover

Evan Taylor, 17, who was shot by his hunting companion, Alvin Smith, near Madin Saturday morning died in a local hospital Sunday morning after surgical measures

had proved unavailing. Taylor, who was employed on the ranch of his brother, A. H. Taylor, had gone to the Staked ranch for a load of straw. Smith was armed with shotguns, and, coming upon a covey of quail, both fired. According to accounts, Smith's gun was accidentally discharged before he had brought it up to his shoulder, the charge entering Taylor's side and abdomen.

Taylor is survived by his mother, Mrs. Lena Dunshey, a brother, A. H. Taylor, and another brother who resides in Washington. An inquest was being held by Coroner Whitlock this afternoon.
