### EIGHT HOURS' GAP IN CLOSING TIME OF ELECTION POLLS

counting votes at 4:34 p. m., eastern time, which will be only 1:34 p. m., on the Pacific coast. The earliest closing time in the country is for rural polling places in New Hampshire at 3 p. m., eastern time. Washington and Oregon, closing at 8 p. m., coast time, or 11 p. m., eastern time, may know the result in some eastern states while their

own voters are still casting their ballots.

Four states specify sunset for the closing of the voting places. The sun will set first on the Virginia. Eleven minutes later, at 5:05 p. m., it will go down on North Carolina, and at 5:36 in Florida.

North Dakota, bisected by the time zone line, which runs just west of Bismarck, the state capital, closes its voting booths at different clock hours, but simultaneously in point of actual time—10 o'clock in the central time zone and 9 o'clock in the mountain time territory, both corresponding to 11 p. m., eastern standard time.

While the members of the tribe looked on, the body was carried in a canoe across the Quinault river, famous as an Indian fishing ground, and deposited in the ancient cemetery beside the grave of Chief Tolobah, famous as a warrior in the annals of the Quinault tribe. No services of any kind marked the deposit of the body in its shallow grave. A huge pile of rocks was the only monument erected by the Indians to mark the spot where their leader rested.
