Hoot Gibson has been an actor from the day he carried off first honors in the all-around cowboy championship contest in 1912 at Pendleton, Oregon, to the final fade-out in "The Galloping Kid," showing at the Liberty today.

When only fifteen, Gibson surrendered to his wanderlust and joined the famous Stanley-Arkison big shows in Australia and lived the life of a trapper for almost three years. He gave the hardest riding Anzacs quite a jolt, when still a mere lad, he defeated them time and again in all-around cowboy contests.

Gibson first broke into motion pictures as a stunt rider and cavalry instructor. In "The Galloping Kid" the star displays much of the brand of riding that has won him the reputation for being the screen's finest horseman.
