

400 CARS ARE ASKED

Emergency Order Sought to Relieve Present Acute Shortage

SACRAMENTO, Dec. 1.—An emergency order for 400 empty box cars daily, for a period of thirty days to relieve the shortage of this class equipment in California, was asked of the interstate commerce commission Friday by the California railroad commission and by representatives of shipping interests in the state.

The Southern Pacific company today supplemented the request to the commission by asking the car service division of the American railway association for immediate release. This step was taken as the outcome of a conference held in San Francisco between the railroad commission, representatives of shippers, the traffic association, chambers of

commerce and the railroad called to consider the car situation which, by the retention of Pacific coast railroad equipment on Eastern lines, has caused an acute situation to develop.

The Southern Pacific company is making every effort to get cars to its own lines, according to the local representatives of the company, who say that once on the Southern Pacific rails, they are rushed with all haste to loading points.
