Eighty-four miners were killed by a freak explosion in the Dolomite coal mine, Birmingham, Ala. The dotted line shows the course of the dump cars which broke away, tore down the tippie and, after going down on the 800-foot incline, crashed into the yard below. Great clouds of coal dust arose. A high-tension electric cable severed at the crash and ignited the dust. In the terrific explosion, 40 men were killed outright at the foot of the tippie. Deadly after-damp accounted for the remainder of the victims.
