5000 NEW CARS ARE ORDERED BY FRUIT EXPRESS

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 12.—Construction of 5000 standard refrigerator cars for delivery early in 1932...

The 5000 standard refrigerator cars are in addition to the 3,500 new cars being built by the company.

Commenting on the new refrigerator car construction, officials of the Southern Pacific company, which owns a half interest in the Pacific Fruit express, point out that the large increase in the latter company's equipment should counteract a repetition of the conditions which caused a car shortage this year.

The new cars will give the Pacific Fruit express a total of between 25,000 and 29,000 cars to be used exclusively for the fruit and vegetable business originating in the states of California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, Texas and Louisiana on the lines of the Southern Pacific and Union Pacific.
