THE LIBERTY

Many weeks of preparation, spent mainly in search of suitable locations and a perfect cast, were required before the first scene of "The Prodigal Judge" was taken. This special production, which will be shown at the Liberty theatre today, is a screen version of the famous novel of the same name by Vaughan Kester.

In this splendid story, one of the most successful novels of its day, with its action laid in the most romantic and beautiful spots along the Ohio, Tennessee and Mississippi rivers in 1835, the characters are all clean-cut types, requiring a cast of unusual merit, down to the least important "bit." For two weeks Director Edward Jose, Casting Director William Dunn and Production Manager William Wright devoted their entire time to casting for the big production and a sufficient number of actors were engaged for the lesser parts.

The cast is headed by Jean Paige whose fame in "Black Beauty" has spread around the world. Speed was sacrificed to quality.

The early scenes was taken at the Cedar Rapids on the St. Lawrence river. Although the exciting passage of a Mississippi river keel boat and a double-cabin raft through the rapids do not appear in the picture until near its end no chance was taken on cold weather interfering with plans. From the Canadian location the entire company went to South Carolina where the early exterior scenes were taken in the vicinity described by the author, and then moved on to Tennessee where the bulk of the outdoor action was made.

Beautiful Claire Adams, whose power as an emotional actress is attracting a great deal of attention in the motion picture circles is seen as "Janet Butler" in "The Dwelling Place of Light," of the Winston Churchill novel, at the Strand theatre tonight. Miss Adams' superb portrayal of the role of "Lenore Anderson" in Hampton's production of the Zane Grey novel, "The Desert of Wheat," won for her the leading role in the Winston Churchill story; the girl who is seeking "The dwelling place of light."

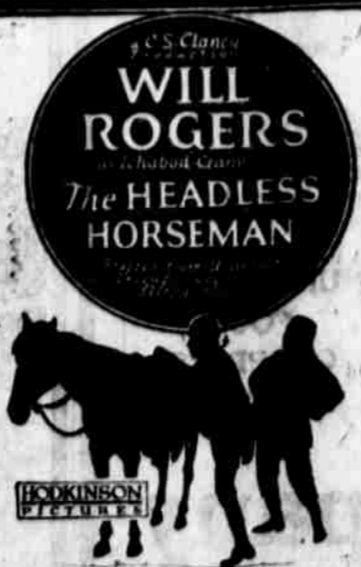
