**100-FOOT SKI SLIDE GOING UP**

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., Dec. 19.—Work has begun on the one hundred foot steel slide at Glenwood Park here, on which slides of the country will participate in the national ski tournament, to be held in Minneapolis February 10 and 11.

Co-operating with the board of park commissioners, the Municipal Ski club of Minneapolis and the Odh club, another local organization, have subscribed toward the erection of the slide. The tournament will be conducted under the auspices of the three bodies.

The outstanding event on the opening day will be the boy's national championship meet, in which all boys under sixteen years of age are eligible to participate. In addition, a dual meet between the University of Minnesota and University of Wisconsin will be held that day.

On the following day, class A and B skiers from all parts of the United States and Canada will compete.

"The Minneapolis tournament will be the biggest in the history of the ski sport and will take on an international aspect with entries coming from Canada," stated L. J. Sverdrup, secretary of the National Ski association.

Among the list who already have made arrangements to attend are delegations from Dartmouth college, Iosco, Mich.; Grand Beach club, Michigan; Denver, Colo.; Revels club, B. C.; Canada; Winnipeg, Montreal, Toronto and Quebec, according to Sverdrup.

There is a revival in skiing and more clubs are organizing now than ever before in the history of the nineteen years of the existence of the National Ski association," Sverdrup said.

**ENOUGH AUTOS IN U. S. TO GIVE WHOLE POPULATION A RIDE**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 19.—There are enough motor vehicles in the United States to take the entire population of the country for a ride at the same time, says the bureau of public roads of the department of agriculture. At the beginning of 1922 there were 4.2 motor vehicles for each mile of road in the United States.

One hundred and twenty vehicles per minute was the rate at which motor vehicles passed a bureau observing station on a trunk line highway in Massachusetts, recently. This rate was continued from noon to ten p. m.

A tourist recently driving through four states was required to buy four different sets of lenses to make his headlights comply with state regulations. In this the bureau sees great need for more uniformity in highway regulations.

Federal-aid highways placed under construction in September amounted to 1,133 miles.
