

TAX DECREASED BY GOVERNMENT SAYS PRESIDENT

reduced, the cost of state and local governments is being just as steadily increased, year by year."

"Take the costs of state government," he said, "I am informed that the revenues of the states in 1913 aggregated \$268,000,000 and that in 1921 they had increased to \$559,000,000; that is, they had increased 101 per cent, and every dollar of that increase had to come in some way or other from the public. The expenditures of the states in 1913 aggregated \$383,000,000, and in 1921 they had increased to \$1,005,000,000; an increase of 163 per cent. The indebtedness of the states in 1913 amounted to \$423,000,000 and in 1921 to \$1,012,000,000, an increase of 139 per cent."

Data of 227 Cities

"Turn now to the cost of city government. The census bureau has compiled data on the governments of 227 of the large cities. It is shown that these cities in 1913 collected \$890,000,000 in all revenues, and in 1921 they collected \$1,567,000,000; that is, they were compelled to take 76 per cent more in taxes in 1921 than they had taken in 1913. The same group of cities expended in 1913, \$1,101,000,000 and in 1921, \$1,726,000,000—an increase of 71 per cent. The total debt of this group of cities in 1913 was \$2,901,000,000, which by 1921 had risen to \$4,334,000,000—an increase of 49 per cent."

"County administration appears, from the rather limited information which at this time the census authorities have been able to produce, to have shown a much larger proportionate increase in cost and tax collections than did the government of cities."

"There is but one way for the community finally to get back on its feet, and that is to go seriously about paying its debts and reducing its expenses. That is what the world must face. The greatest and richest government must face it, and so must the humblest citizen."

"If I could urge upon the American people a single rule applicable to every one of them as individuals and to every political or corporate unit among them, it would be to learn to spend somewhat less than your income all the time. If you have debts, reduce them as rapidly as you can; if you are one of the fortunate few who have no debts, make it a rule to save something every year."

GRAIN RATES CLIMB

Railroads of West Authorized To Make 10 Per Cent Increase

WASHINGTON, June 27.—Railroads operating in Rocky mountain and Pacific territory were in effect authorized today by the interstate commerce commission to increase by 10 per cent freight rates on corn and cereal products usually classified as coarse grain. The grain, which does not affect wheat, was authorized in shipments from Mississippi valley points to the Rocky mountain-Pacific coast area.

LOUIS KNIGHT HELD TO FEDERAL JURY

Evidence Introduced At Hearing Indicated Purpose Was To Sell Liquor At Beatty Dance

Louis Knight, arrested June 18, on a charge of having liquor in his possession, introducing it onto the reservation and bartering it, was bound over to the federal grand jury yesterday by Bert C. Thomas, U. S. commissioner.

The evidence introduced in the case showed that night is a resident of Chiloquin, and that on the night of June 14 he took a keg of moonshine whiskey to Beatty where a dance was being held, with the intention of selling the liquor. It was sold a half interest in the keg to one Toy Brown, but the partnership

did not prove profitable, as the two gave away more of the liquor than they sold.

The following day, the evidence showed, a drinking party was held around the keg, with the participants taking turns drinking through a rubber hose. One of them, Everett Lynch, drank enough to send him home in an ugly mood, and it was after he had severely beaten his wife, that a search for the liquor was instituted, and the keg, which had been hidden, was discovered by Watson Duffy, Indian policeman.

Knight is trying to raise \$1000 bail. He gave that amount June 22, four days after his arrest.

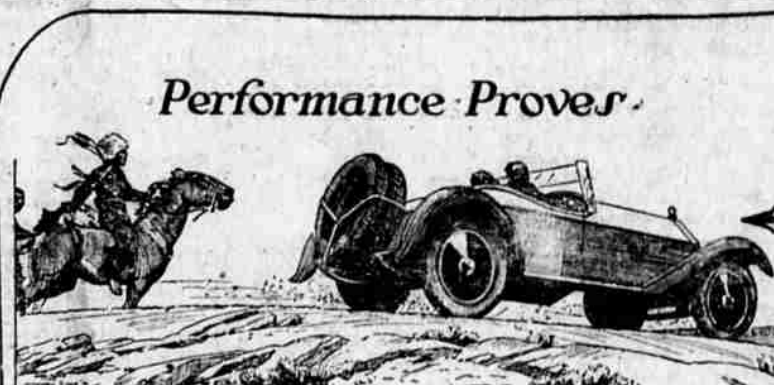
