World's Only Gambling School



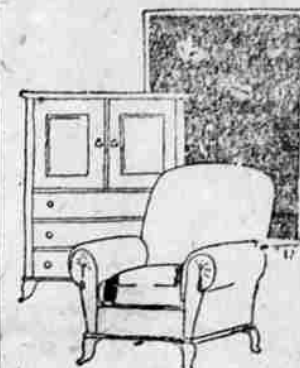
