Georgians Want Permission To Recover Body of State's Founder

LONDON, Sept. 13.—An American institute of learning, Georgia University, has petitioned the ecclesiastical authorities for permission to do some digging in the Granham church, near Upminster, Essex, to find out if the remains of General Oglethorpe are there. If the body is found, the university will ask further permission to ship it across the Atlantic and place it in a shrine at the institution.

There is no doubt he was buried in the church. There is a tablet to his memory on which it is recorded that he was born in 1696 and died in 1733. An account is given also of his achievements. In June, 1732, with twenty associates, the general obtained a charter for the settlement of the Georgia colony from King George II. He was the friend of many distinguished men of his time, among them Walpole, Goldsmith, Boswell, Burke and Pope. The

last enshrined his name in a couplet.

EMIGRATION OF GERMANS TO CANADA OPPOSED

MUNICH, Sept. 13.—Leading Bavarian newspapers have launched a campaign opposing the proposed emigration of Bavarians to Canada, unless there be a "cessation of anti-German and war guilt propaganda in Canada."

Answering statements published recently as offering free transportation to Central European farmer-emigrants, the press attacks the project, alleging that Canada, because of unemployment and the present price of grain, is little more attractive than their homeland to the farmers.

IDaho MAN HAS SILVER MINE IN BACK YARD

KELLOGG, Idaho, Sept. 13.—Having discovered a silver lead mine in his own back yard at Clark's

Fork, Idaho, Dr. A. H. Wilson, state health inspector, is planning an extraordinary mining enterprise, according to reports here. Samples of the ore from Dr. Wilson's back yard are reported to have a value of \$125 a ton in silver and lead, and as it lies right at the grass roots a scoop shovel is all the mining apparatus necessary at present for taking some quantities of the precious rock, it is said. Plans are now underway for a systematic development of the showing.
